

Mellon Park



Address for Mellon Field: Fifth Ave at Beechwood Blvd, Pittsburgh, PA 15206.

From Downtown/South Hills

- Take US-22 E/I-376 E towards Monroeville.
- Take the Forbes Avenue Exit, #2A, towards OAKLAND.
- Follow Forbes Avenue about 1.5 miles. Turn Left onto Morewood Avenue (at CMU).
- At the first traffic light, turn Right onto Fifth Avenue. Follow Fifth Avenue about 1.3 miles.
- Turn right on Beechwood blvd for street parking (the field is on the right)

From East of Pittsburgh (Monroeville, etc)

- Take US-22 W/I-376 W towards Pittsburgh.
- Merge onto PA-8 N via Exit 8B toward WILKINSBURG
- Follow Penn Ave to Fifth Avenue, make a Left onto Fifth.
- The field will be on your right after you turn (turn left on Beechwood Blvd. for additional street parking)

From North of Pittsburgh

- From I-79 S, take I-279 S toward PITTSBURGH
- Merge onto I-579 S via Exit 8A towards VETERANS BRIDGE
- Take the exit toward I-376 E/OAKLAND/MONROEVILLE
- Stay straight to go onto BOULEVARD OF THE ALLIES
- Take the FORBES AVE ramp
- Turn slight Left onto FORBES AVE
- Turn Left onto MOREWOOD AVE
- Turn Right at first light, onto FIFTH AVE
- Turn right on Beechwood blvd. for street parking (the field is on the right)



Game Day Information

General

- All players should sign the waiver located on your dashboard through our website. There will be extras at the PUMP table if needed day-of.
- Rosters must be submitted in full by Wednesday August 7th.
- All registration fees must be paid in full by Wednesday August 7th.
- You are welcome to bring tents and lawn games for your team.
- You will find the best parking options on Beechwood Blvd. We strongly suggest that you carpool if you can.
- You are not allowed to drive or park within the trails/emergency roads within the park. You will be ticketed by the Police if you attempt this.
- Remember that Kickball for a Cause is a charity tournament; make sure to stay on time, show good sportsmanship and always clean up after yourself!
- 50/50 Raffle: Starting at 9:30 AM, you can purchase 50/50 tickets (7 for \$5, Arm's length for \$10, Wingspan for \$20) at the table next to the ID check. PUMP representatives will also be selling tickets from 12:00-1:30 PM throughout the Kickball for a Cause fields. Cash and card are accepted. The winner will be announced at 2 PM via the DJ, twitter, and Instagram (@PUMP_PSL). The winner will have 24 hours to claim their 50/50 prize. If unclaimed after 24 hours, the winnings will be donated directly to the Causes.
- A DJ will be provided from 11-3!
- From 3:30-4:30 we will leave the Pittsburgh Pedal Boat field open and set up for individuals who want to continue to play kickball. Any games that are played are welcome to use our equipment but will not be organized by us and there will not be a referee provided it is pick-up style and player organized! Please be inclusive.
- Please tag us in your pictures and memories! Instagram & Twitter: PUMP_PSL & #K4aC19 and we have a Snapchat filter for the event!

Alcohol

- No outside alcohol is permitted on the Kickball for a Cause grounds. We will serve beer until 5:00 pm or until it runs out whichever comes first.
- Players MUST bring their ID's to drink: We'll start checking IDs and distributing wristbands at 9:30AM at the 50/50 and ID check tent (see map). Beer will be served starting at 10:30 AM.
- Only persons in their Kickball for a Cause t-shirts and wearing wristbands will be served alcohol.
- You are encouraged to bring your cup back to the bartenders for reuse.
- There is a No Drinking Alcohol at the games policy. Alcoholic drinks must be kept at your picnic areas. Any player who is playing a game should not be drinking.
- There is no alcohol permitted within the playground/water park or in any of the No Alcohol Zones (see map).

Food & Beverage

- We will have water & Gatorade stations at each field that players can use to stay hydrated during their
 games. <u>Please encourage everyone to bring their own water bottles</u> to refill at these stations to help reduce
 waste. Umpires, staff and volunteers will also be walking around to make sure players are not drinking alcohol at
 the field during their games.
- Teams are welcome to bring their own coolers, non-alcoholic beverages and food.

- Allegheny Coffee and Tea Exchange will be serving hot brewed coffee, cold brewed coffee, decaf coffee and iced tea from 8:15 am and lasting throughout the duration of the day at the Pavilion.
- There will be light snacks (i.e. chips and granola bars) throughout the day at the Pavilion.
- Lunch will be served in waves (see below) and can be picked up at the pavilion anytime during your allotted time.
 - Lunch, compliments of Bigham Tavern, includes a sandwich or wrap, and fruit salad.
 - Teams may pick up lunch and eat at their tent.
 - In addition to the water, Gatorade and Coffee/Tea products there will also be pop options to go with lunch.
- For dessert we will have cookies, compliments of Eat N' Park.
- Beer, compliments of MillerCoors will served on draft.

2019 Policies

PUMP is committed to hosting an event that raises money for important Pittsburgh nonprofits while providing a fun, respectful, healthy, and safe environment for all Kickball for a Cause participants. We encourage every participant to carefully read the following rules and policies as they are designed to help maintain and fun and safe environment.

Alcohol Policy:

Admission:

- Participants will not be permitted to bring any outside alcohol onto the Kickball for a Cause grounds while we are serving alcohol.
- Participants must present a valid government-issued ID to receive a wristband. Wristbands may be picked up beginning at 9:30AM at the 50/50 and ID Check table.

During the event:

- Participants must be at least 21 years old to be served and consume alcohol
- Only participants with wristbands and wearing a 2019 Kickball for a Cause shirt may drink alcohol
- Alcohol is only permitted in designated areas
- Participants are not permitted to drink alcohol at fields during game play
- Designated bartenders will start serving beer at 10:30 AM
- A maximum of two beers per participant will be served at a time
- Participants who show visible signs of intoxication will not be served and will be removed from the tournament

Disciplinary Action:

Any Kickball for a Cause participant, or guest, who violates PUMP's alcohol policy will be subject to the following actions:

- First Offense: participant will be asked to turn-over the alcohol in-question to PUMP staff immediately
- Second Offense: participant will be removed from tournament

Enforcement:

All bartenders, PUMP staff, and event volunteers have the ability to enforce alcohol rules and disciplinary action.

PUMP reserves the right to skip any of the above outlined steps or apply disciplinary measures to additional team members if the nature of the offense warrants such action. PUMP also reserves the right to ban offending participants and teammates from future Kickball for a Cause tournaments.

T-shirt Policy:

All tournament participants must wear the official 2019 Kickball for a Cause t-shirts provided by PUMP staff while on the tournament grounds. Participants wearing alternative t-shirts will be required to change into the appropriate shirt in order to play and enjoy the tournament festivities.

Sponsor Policy:

Other than official Kickball for a Cause tournament sponsors, no outside signage, sponsor marks, or logos are permitted on the tournament grounds. If appropriate, you are welcome to create a team name that highlights an alternative sponsor.

Prize & Sportsmanship:

The prize for this year's Kickball for a Cause Champions is one Pittsburgh Pedal Boat, which fits between 14-16 people; \$100 gift card to Giant Eagle; 2 cases of MillerCoors beer; a pre-registered fall 2019 PSL team on the night and at the field of their choosing (note that the full team price will still be owed by the team; and team medals.

The second place team will receive a \$100 gift card to Bigham Tavern.

The prizes will be on-site, ready to be handed to the championship teams directly before the Championship picture is taken in front of the PUMP sign following the last game. Please note that this is a charity event and sportsmanship is prized above all else. Teams who do not behave in a sportsmanlike manner will not be allowed to continue to play throughout the day and into playoffs. You will be ranked on your sportsmanship at each game!



Schedule

The round robin tournament games will be 5 innings (35 minutes), whichever comes first.

Games cannot end in ties. Please see rules for overtime play.

The full schedule is also posted on LeagueLab through your Player Page. You can follow scores and standings throughout the day on your mobile phone during the tournament!

The schedule will be updated on our website as soon as possible for playoff seedings. Please be patient. To see the seedings for playoffs you must tune into your online schedule.



Single Elimination Championship Tournament

All playoff games are 5 innings.

- 12 Teams total the top nine teams (**the top team from each division**) and three wildcards will advance to the single elimination championship bracket. The second place teams from each division are eligible for wildcard spots based on the following ranking:
- 1. Number of wins
- 2. Head to Head
- 3. Least runs allowed
- 4. Most runs scored
- 5. Sportsmanship Behavior throughout the tournament your officials will be ranking all teams throughout the day.





Sportsmanship Behavior

The PSL strives to provide a safe, welcoming, inclusive, and fun atmosphere while providing a high quality recreational experience for all participants. We place a high priority on sportsmanship and expect it to be displayed throughout at all times.

Unsportsmanlike behavior includes but is not limited to the berating of an official, harassment of another individual, use of slurs or other offensive language, threats, dangerous or excessive physical play, lying or misrepresenting your identity, and any other behavior deemed inappropriate by an official, referee, or a PSL staff member. Note that any player whose words or actions negatively impact an inclusive and welcoming atmosphere at PSL games and events will also be considered unsportsmanlike behavior.

At the end of each game our officials will be rating each team on their sportsmanship throughout the game on a scale of 1-3. This will be used as a tiebreaker for playoffs.

- 3: Excellent Conduct and Sportsmanship: The team goes above and beyond in creating a fun and sportsmanlike environment. Players cooperate fully with the officials and other team members. The captain calmly converses with officials about rule interpretations and calls. The captains have full control of their teammates.
- 2: Average Conduct and Sportsmanship: Team members verbally question some decisions made by the officials but remain respectful. Captains exhibit control over their team and themselves. The team overall displays sportsmanship.
- 1: Poor Conduct and Sportsmanship: Team is uncooperative, combative with the officials or members of the other team. The Captain does not have control over teammates or themselves. The team creates an atmosphere that ruins the sportsmanlike environment between commenting on plays, fighting, harassing, etc.

PUMP is going green once again at Kickball for a Cause!

This is our 4th year as a Zero Waste event! Our goal is to reduce our landfill waste down to 10% - with all other items to be composted or recycled.

We are doing our part by reducing packaging and bringing compostable and recyclable materials to the event, but we need your help with the rest!

To make things easier, we will have volunteers collecting and sorting your items at the main Zero Waste Zone near the lunch pavilion. Please do NOT combine your recycling, food waste, cups, trash, etc. at your picnic area. This makes for a soppy mess that volunteers must dig through in order to sort it later. Just bring everything to the Zero Waste Zone so we can take care of it while you get back to your games.



A few requests:

- PLEASE commit to bringing your own water bottle to refill with water throughout the event.
- PLEASE use and re-use compostable cups we are providing for all drinks (beer, lemonade, Gatorade, coffee, etc). Remember to hold onto your cup for refills!
- PLEASE do NOT bring non-recyclable SOLO-style cups for your team's bar-style games. In general, try to avoid items that can't be composted/recycled. Only plastic bottles, plastic jugs, plastic tubs, aluminum cans, clean plastic film, and mixed paper can be recycled in Pittsburgh.
- PLEASE be prepared to sort your waste at the tournament with the help of our awesome Green Team volunteers and labeled bins.
